

**Please Drive with Extra Care as you drive through our Village!**

Dear Village Residents,

I am dedicating this month's letter to one subject.....Safety and Dogs.

Since being elected and sworn in for my first term as your Village Mayor back in April 2011, I have made SAFETY my number one priority. Your village staff fully understands that, and under no instance will there be any deviation to this priority.

Along that line, it is imperative that dogs be kept on a leash while off the property of its owner. In fact, Chapter 11 of our Village Code clearly states that:

**11-1. Dogs "at large" are prohibited.**

**"It shall be unlawful for a dog to be on public property or on private property without the consent of the owner.....of such private property unless the dog is effectively restrained in the immediate custody and control of its owner....by a chain or leash not exceeding six feet in length".**

Please obey our above Village Law. Not doing so can possibly create unsafe conditions for everyone (including your dog).

And if you should spot a dog that is not on a leash, or otherwise not under the full control of its' owner (in violation of our law), than I encourage you to contact the police department immediately, in order to avoid possible mishaps or injury.

Prevention is always better than dealing with an unsafe situation.

Back to you in September. In the meantime, enjoy your summer.
