

Dear Village Residents,

Season's Greetings to all! And I wish everyone a Happy Thanksgiving.

Roslyn Water District: You may have noticed some construction activity being performed at the Roslyn Water Districts' (RWD) facility located on Mineola Avenue, just north of The Maples. Since it has been a few months since we last heard about water issues, I thought it would be timely, and appropriate, to give you an update with some details of what is occurring, or expected to occur, in our Village.

As a reminder, you will recall almost a year ago (in early 2014) the RWD requested approval of a bond from the Town of North Hempstead, in order to allow them to make necessary improvements to their facilities throughout the district. As a reminder, this request included the installation of two Air Strippers within our Village; one along Diana's Trail and a second one on the RWD's property on Mineola Avenue. After numerous meetings and hearings held by the RWD, the Town and the Village, the RWD was asked to consider relocating the air stripper proposed for Diana's Trail, into Christopher Morley Park. Well, we have been working with the RWD and a number of both elected and appointed government officials to make this happen and ultimately to receive authorization of the installation of the air stripper in Christopher Morely Park. We understand that it is currently on the Governor's desk for signature and hopeful to have it signed shortly.

As we all know, since the RWD was unable to get the Diana's Trail Air Stripper installed last summer, watering restrictions were put into place which were hugely successful, thanks in part to the diligent compliance of our Village residents. As a result, the RWD tells us that they were able to avoid any water or pressure issues. They have expressed their gratitude which I am happy to share with you.

Recently, construction began on the Mineola Avenue site to prepare for the installation of that Air Stripper, which is scheduled to be completed by early summer 2015. Additionally, when the rendering of the building is completed the Water District will provide it to the Village's ARB for comment. We have also been told that they intend to put the rendering on their website to ensure complete transparency to our community.
