

Dear Village Residents,

It has been a long and challenging winter that has kept so many of us trapped indoors. And before I forget, I want to thank our village staff for doing an outstanding job in keeping our roads cleared and safe during this difficult season.

I am glad to see many of our neighbors “out and about” as the weather warms up.

Annual Meeting - Our April meeting happens to be the Village’s ANNUAL Meeting. Everyone is invited & encouraged to attend. Additionally, at this meeting, a public hearing will be held to review the annual budget for next (2014/2015) year.

Village Elections – Last month our village elections were held for two expiring Trustee positions. I am pleased to report that both incumbents, Dr. Sandy Joel Siff and Dr. Brian Feingold, were re-elected for an additional two year term. They both ran unopposed. I wish to personally congratulate them and thank them for caring enough to continue serving the Village, in this valuable roll, without compensation.

Pet Food Drive – NYS Senator Jack Martins is leading a pet food drive and has asked us to help in that effort. I know our Village is loaded with pet lovers and hope you will consider supporting this event. A collection bin has been placed in Village Hall and I encourage you to stop by if you are inclined to participate.

For our dog lovers - Please make sure your dogs have identification tags. In the past month alone, we have found three lost dogs roaming our village, without tags, presenting us with great difficulty in returning them to their owners. Also, please remember that all dogs must be kept on a leash (when on public property) and to pick up after your dog for the safety and consideration of your fellow residents.

Roslyn Water District/Diana’s Trail Project - As an update, many of you are aware that the officials of the RWD have been working along with ourselves, Nassau County, the Town of North Hempstead, and various local elected officials in an attempt to move the air stripper (slated for installation at the Diana’s Trail well site) outside of our Village and onto a parcel of land located in Christopher Morley Park. I am pleased with the efforts and focus that has been put forth so far in that regard. Those efforts will continue in full force until a decision has been reached, which I anticipate will occur before my next monthly Mayors Letter. Once that occurs, I will notify our community immediately. In the meantime, the water district has agreed to allow irrigation to occur on a limited basis.

- a. Construction for some road maintenance work will commence later this month and will likely continue for several weeks. We ask for your patience as we are pressing to get this needed work completed before the start of summer,
- b. Please remember to set your alarms, turn on lights, and take precautions to avoid and discourage criminal activity. We have had a terrific track record for the past several years and of course, we want to continue along that path. Lastly if you notice anything that is suspect, please do not hesitate to call 9-1-1.
- c. Construction, either on weekends or during the evening, or without a permit, is expressly prohibited. Please comply with this in consideration of your neighbors.
- d. We are in the process of finalizing information that will be published in a new and updated village directory. If the village does not have your current information, contact Bryan or Sandy without delay, as we expect to go to press by Friday.
