

Dear Village Residents,

What a busy month in the Village! Your Board of Trustees has been working on the Roslyn Water District (RWD) issue and I have some new information to share with you. I also have some other items that you will find important so let's get to it:

Water: As you know, the RWD appeared before the Town of North Hempstead, at a Public Hearing, seeking approval for a \$20.9 million bond to fund various projects, including a proposed remediation system (Air Stripper) on Diana's Trail, in our Village. The Town adjourned the public hearing and directed the RWD officials and their consultants to meet with interested water district residents, to answer our questions and provide more detail about the project.

Many concerns and unanswered questions remain that must be addressed to our satisfaction as a community. **The RWD will be holding a public meeting on Tuesday, February 11th at 7:30pm at the East Hills Park Theatre.** As a reminder, the Public Hearing with the Town Board will resume on February 25th.

To prepare for the February 11th meeting, your Village Board will host a meeting for our Village residents, to ensure that the RWD comes up with the best possible solution for our Village. Our Village attorney and Village engineers will be attending. We will ask our engineers, who have expertise in public water supply projects, to be prepared to discuss the pros and cons of the RWD proposal and any feasible alternatives.

The special Village Board meeting will be held on **Wednesday, February 5th at 7:00pm at Village Hall.** I encourage all our residents to attend so we may come to a solution that works best for our Village.

Tentative Assessment 2014/15: As a point of information, please note that the 2014-2015 Tentative (Property Tax) Assessment Roll will be available for all to see on our website (www.villageofroslynestates.com) on February 1st and available at Village Hall starting on Monday, February 3rd.

If you do not agree with the information contained in the roll, you only have between February 1st and February 18, 2014 4:00 pm to file a Tax Grievance Application with the Village, one original and two copies. February 18th is tax grievance day and our tax assessor will be available to answer any questions that day.

Traffic Safety: The number one complaint that I receive is about motorists speeding and ignoring traffic signage in the Village. I have been working with the 3rd Precinct to increase enforcement in the Village. I am happy to report that we have seen an increase of police enforcement and you may have noticed more police cars in the Village. However, if you have any locations that need to be monitored contact Village Hall so they can inform the precinct to watch these locations.

Monthly Board Meetings: As always, please feel free to join us at our monthly Board of Trustees meetings. It is a pleasure to see our Village residents in attendance and I have attached a copy of our (tentative) agenda for your information and consideration.
