

Dear Village Residents,

It's middle of the winter and.....so far so good. Hopefully everyone has gotten to this point safely and there have been no unfortunate incidents. And on that note, let me express my appreciation to our Village staff who, in my view, have done an outstanding job with our roads so far this winter season. In fact, I have received a number of calls and emails with particularly kind words, which I have shared with our staff. Those sorts of notes are always appreciated.....by me.....by our Village staff. As always, safety is not only our main goal, but it is always at the forefront of everything we do.

**Village Elections:**

Each year our Village holds its elections on the third Tuesday in March. This year though, our elections will be held at our Village Hall, on WEDNESDAY, March 18<sup>th</sup>. Please jot that down so you don't forget. Positions scheduled to expire (up for election) are 2 Board of Trustees seats as well as the position of Village Mayor. Voting hours will begin at 6:00a.m. and will continue throughout the day until 9:00p.m. to accommodate our wide array of varying schedules.

**Tentative Tax Assessment Roll:**

The Tentative (property tax) Assessment roll is available to be reviewed at Village Hall. If you want to review it, please feel free to do so. Important to note is that you can only grieve your village taxes until "Assessment Grievance Day", February 17<sup>th</sup> (the third Tuesday in February). So if you are planning to do so, or have concerns about your (Village) property taxes for the upcoming (2015-2016) year, please make sure you review the information in a timely fashion.

**Safety on our Village Roads:**

A reminder to all, please drive cautiously throughout the Village, particularly in the evenings, as the Village tends to be a bit dark, and our roads are winding. We recently had an incident where a pedestrian was hit by a car along our Village's northerly perimeter. We believe weather conditions and the fact that she was wearing dark clothing; both may have contributed to the incident. So please, be careful when walking outside, particularly in the evenings. I suggest you wear bright (perhaps reflective) clothing and you might consider carrying a flashlight.

**Roslyn Water District/ Air Strippers- Update**

As a reminder, the construction of the Air Stripper being installed on Mineola Ave (just north of the intersection of The Maples) had begun a few months ago and is expected to be completed and operational, by this Summer. The second Air Stripper, expected to be installed just outside the Village's southern boundary (in Christopher Morley Park), has not yet begun construction. Although the Governor has signed the bill approving this installation, approval from the Nassau County Legislature is required, which has not yet occurred. Of course, both of these projects are "Roslyn Water District" projects & inquiries may be directed to them.

### **Emergency Contact Information**

Although it may be hard to believe, we still do not have Emergency Contact information for all Village residents. This is extremely important. A number of incidents have occurred over the past several years, which had considerable impact that could have been avoided, or minimized, had we had a way to reach property owners. Please, if you have not already done so, provide your contact information to our Village office. If an unfortunate incident occurs that affects your property, you will be glad you gave us that information.
