

Dear Residents:

I hope everyone had a nice start to the new year. We have had some wonderfully mild weather which hopefully will continue through the remainder of the winter. And, as always, a reminder to please be extra courteous of our children and our pets while driving through our Village. Some things I wanted to share:

**Upcoming Road Work**

Last year our Village retained the services of our Village Engineers to study and determine the conditions of our (nearly 8 miles of) Village Roads. Overall, the Engineer that prepared the report indicated that our roads are generally in “very good” condition. We were pleased to learn that. The report was quite comprehensive and essentially placed a rating on the conditions of each of our roads. In effect, each street was “ranked”. With a view towards protecting and improving our village roads, the Board of Trustees then decided to proceed with a road repair and improvement project that will focus on those areas of roads which were rated the poorest. I wanted to keep everyone informed about this as we will begin the road work in the early Spring. Weather permitting, our intention is to complete the work before Memorial Day, so that we can all enjoy the Village’s beauty, during the warm Summer season.

**Village Elections**

As always, our Village elections will be held in March. As a reminder, this year the Village Mayor, Village Justice and three Trustee positions are up for election. Please exercise your right to vote on Election Day. You can do so conveniently, at Village Hall on Tuesday, March 21<sup>st</sup>. Our polls will be opened all day, from 6:00 am until 9:00pm.

**Property Taxes**

Our Village staff has finalized the Tentative Tax Assessment Roll, for the Village portion of property taxes for the 2017/2018 tax year. That information will be available at Village Hall and on our website, on February 1<sup>st</sup>. Please note, Tax Grievances will only be received by the Village up through February 21<sup>st</sup>.
