

Dear Residents:

Village Elections:

A reminder to vote. Our Village elections will be held on March 15th for two Village Trustee positions, whose terms are expiring. You can do so conveniently at Village Hall, at 25 The Tulips. Our polls will be opened all day, from 6:00 am until 9:00pm.

Security and Safety:

One of the complaints that I receive often, is about commuters that “cut through” our Village, particularly during the early morning hours. To try to address this concern, the Board of Trustees has approved, on a trial basis, traffic signage that will prohibit entry into the village for all traffic heading Northbound on Searingtown Road onto The Spur between 7am and 9am on weekday mornings. Keep in mind, this restriction applies to all motorists, residents and non-residents alike.

Additionally, “No Outlet” signs will be installed at Diana’s Trail and the North Branch points of entry to discourage traffic flow into the Village in general. Perhaps this will improve this situation, which seems to have gotten a bit worse over the past few months. We will let the police know about this plan and will request increased police presence and enforcement to reinforce these actions. Of course, any traffic violations that are issued in this regard will flow through our Village’s Justice Court.

Dog Poop:

A reminder that our Village law requires all owners to pick up after their dogs. So please do not forget to do so. It is not only illegal, but it is unsanitary and inconsiderate of our neighbors.
