

In addition, all dogs must be leashed when off your property and please clean up after them. If you notice an unleashed or a stray dog please contact the 3rd precinct at 516-573-6300.

Road Repair/ Maintenance – The contract with our road maintenance subcontractor has now been secured and as a result, I expect our road construction work it will begin during the week of September 8th. The work is only expected to take a few weeks. I would ask that we all be a bit patient and careful, when driving around the village during this time.
