

Security and Safety:

As you know, the Village has installed “No Right Turn b/w 7-9am M-F” on Searingtown Road northbound at The Spur to deter cut through traffic. So far it seems to be working with great success and has changed driver's patterns. In addition, the police have issued at least 150+ tickets since it has been installed.

In our continuing efforts to further reduce the amount of traffic cutting through the Village in the morning and evening, new signage has been installed (on a trial basis) at the following locations:

- **“No Right Turn b/w 4-6pm M-F” on The Locusts southbound at The Oaks**
- **“No Right Turn b/w 4-6pm M-F” on The Locusts southbound at The Birches**
- **“No Left Turn b/w 7-9am M-F” on Diana's Trail eastbound at South Branch**

The police will begin monitoring these locations so please plan accordingly.
